**Job Description**

**Role and Responsibilities**  
 The Head Coach of the University of Michigan Women's Rugby Football Club works with the club's administration board, captains, and B1G Commissioners to develop the club and its players. The part-time position requires the ability, desire, and passion to coach players with vast differences in experience and promote the sport of rugby among young women.

- Required Qualifications**
- The ability to promote an inclusive and supportive team atmosphere while teaching the game of rugby to a variety of skill levels
  - Knowledgeable - and passionate! - about rugby (15s *and* 7s; forwards *and* backs) either through experience playing at the Club/College/Elite level or through coaching
  - USA Rugby Level 200 Coaching Certification
    - Must currently hold Level 200 license or be available to earn qualification prior to Sept 2018 (with support from UMWRFC)
  - Able to commit to 6 hours of practice a week and traveling with the team on weekends
    - This includes the Fall and Spring Seasons (Sept-Nov and Jan-May)
    - The current Big 10 leagues includes the furthest drive being to Penn State University; however, events such as Nationals and tournaments may require further travel
  - Good communication skills (will be working with admin/captains/assistant coaches/B1G commissioners/USA Rugby)
    - The coach may bring new assistant coaches to help; however, they will need to be interviewed by the team's admin as well
    - Assistant coaches are needed as practice can bring out 25-35 athletes
  - Transportation to/from Ann Arbor for practices and home games
    - The team will support travel to away games. This will require the coach to meet with the team in Ann Arbor prior to travel
  - The coach must have another source of income, this position does not pay a full time wage.

  - Physically able to demonstrate skills and drills
  - Holds USAR officiating license
